

Laura McHolm and her company NorthStar Moving support a number of nonprofit organizations, with particular emphasis on Claire's Place Foundation, Inc., which is a non-profit organization designed to help children and families affected by cystic fibrosis, and the summer food drive competition that McHolm founded in 2013, "Let's Send Hunger Packing," to feed hungry children.

McHolm designed the food drive to be a competition to help drive more donations. The organization does not provide daycare, leaving her to seek out the appropriate care providers that are able to handle children with special needs. She also provides extracurricular activities for her children, so that they are able to learn important social skills and behavioral development.

CHUCK RUBIN OWNER HOLLYWOOD GROOMING




CHUCK Rubin, the founder of Hollywood Grooming and creator of his "PAW it Forward, Rescue Grooming Saves Lives" program, is a hero to local animal rescues and city shelters. His staff of groomers including himself and his wife Yael plus their five grooming trucks transforms matted, dirty looking dogs and cats into attractive, adoptable ones by incredible makeovers.

Hollywood Grooming has transformed "hundreds" of homeless dog and cats into beautiful pets that found loving homes through events where he and his grooming team volunteers their time, grooming trucks, and supplies to save animals lives at our city shelters. This past Christmas, Hollywood Grooming went to downtown LA Skid Row and for six hours groomed every pet brought to the event by the homeless including many pit bulls, plus they brought a Santa Claus and gifts for all the kids at Union Rescue Mission which is where the grooming event was held.

"It's such a great group of girls," said Medina of the contestants. "They all (compete) for different reasons - for nonprofits, college (scholarships)."

After that first positive experience, the salon has been a part of several more pageants in California such as being the official airbrush artist for the 2015 Miss Malibu, 2013 Miss California and 2013 Miss California Teen.

"(The pageants) are based on more than how good you look in a bathing suit," said Medina. "They want to know, what are they doing in their community, how well do they speak in public. These girls work really hard, they are rocking it."

Medina said she is also glad to work with production companies like Toay and Capture, who will give 50 percent of the proceeds of Sunday's pageant to Beauties & Athletes Against Bullying, to help decrease the rate of child and teen bullying and cyber bullying.

"I personally have dealt with bullying issues," said the single mother of three.

Medina said her mixed-race 10-year-old is sometimes picked on when other children see her with her 3-year-old adopted sister and foster brother.

"They tell her, 'you're not sisters, you don't look the same'," said Medina. "She asks me, 'Why do they say that? We both have two legs, two arms and two eyes, we look exactly the same'."

In the business for more than 10 years, Medina started out with a tanning salon franchise before going out on her own. She eventually expanded her tanning services with a full-service salon offering hair, makeup, and coming soon, manicure and pedicure services, as well as UV, airbrush and spray tanning.



"We want to make sure each person is validated (when they leave the salon)," said Medina. "It makes me feel good to see them be so confident."






